As we did in 2023, we are automatically renewing retailer licenses for 2024*. You will receive your 2024 PA Lottery License prior to the expiration date of your current license.

## Alexander Wagenhurst, Stock Clerk, Lehigh Valley Lottery office, 2 years of service

- What is your role at the PA Lottery? I am the stock clerk for the Lehigh Valley Lottery office. I maintain the warehouse and assist with inventory management.
- What are you most excited about related to Lottery Modernization? I am excited for the new Scratch-Off return process and excited to see how well the new End Zone Cash Xpress Sports game will be received by retailers and players.
- What tip do you have for PA Lottery retailers?

Speak with your DSR about what items are available in our office warehouse that can help to make your store a Lottery destination, such as signs and scratch stands.


Ryan Gesell, Accessiblity Manager, Lottery Headquarters, 18 years of service

- What is your role at the PA Lottery?

I manage the PA Lottery's Accessibility Program, providing training and support on current ADA regulations and guidelines to the field staff. I also visit retailers ensure compliance and offer any assistance in becoming ADA compliant.

- Can you tell us a little more about the PA Lottery Accessibility Program?

The PA Lottery Accessibility Program allows retailers who are not compliant with current ADA regulations and guidelines time to come into compliance while continuing to sell Lottery. The program also provides financial assistance to help offset the cost of any modifications the retailer has to make to come into compliance.

- Why is accessibility important? Accessibility is important because it allows individuals with various disabilities to function in society independently and allows them to access things and places on their own.
- Do you have any tips for PA Lottery retailers?

PA Lottery retailers should be conscious of their disabled community and redeem winners/payout. That helps encourage customers to come back to play.


## Bryan Gibbons, Area Office Manager, Pittsburgh Lottery Office, 13 years of service

- What is your role at the PA Lottery?

My team and I are responsible for the activity and performance of the 30 Pittsburgh Lottery office staff members and around 1,840 retailers. Our mantra is increasing sales, recruiting new monitor locations, and managing our accounts by opportunity. I am here to ensure we work in unison as a cohesive unit to achieve our goals.
-What are you most excited about related to Lottery modernization?
I really like the new equipment (WAVE 8 and PHDS vending machine) and their capabilities.

- What tips do you have for PA Lottery retailers?

Make Lottery visible, pay out winners, activate the new blitz games within two days, and upsell, upsell, upsell.
