## Important Modernization Message

As we upgrade our equipment in advance of our modernization go-live scheduled for spring of 2024, new features will become available to retailers. One new feature, only available on the Wave 8, is the Special Occasion Button. This button allows for a message to print on Draw Game tickets, such as 'Happy Birthday.'

To activate the Special Occasion messaging,
you will click on the Special Occasion button on the top right of the WAVE 8 toolbar. A pop-up will appear, providing options for the different occasion messages. Once an occasion is selected, the message will print on the next Draw Game ticket. The Special Occasion message will continue to print on all future Draw Game purchases until you cancel it.

NOTE: If there are multiple plays on a ticket,
the selected Special Occasion will print on each of the tickets in that transaction. Special Occasion messages will only print on Draw Game tickets, not Fast Play tickets. To learn more, please review the updated What's New On The WAVE 8 eLearning course.
